OFFENSE

QUARTERBACKS: stance, exchange, drops, set up, release, follow through, reading defenses, passing routes.

RUNNING BACKS: stance release, ball handling, faking, blocking, receiving.

WIDE RECEIVERS: stance, release, running routes, catching, open field blocking.

TIGHT ENDS: stance, release, run and pass blocking, running routes, catching, open field blocking.

OFFENSIVE LINE: stance, run blocking techniques, pulls, pass protection.

DEFENSE

DEFENSIVE LINE: stance, keys, run defense, pass rush.

OUTSIDE LINEBACKERS/DEFENSIVE ENDS: stance, keys, run reads, pass defense, pass drops, rush technique.

INSIDE LINEBACKERS: stance, keys, run reads, pass reads/drops.

SECONDARY: stance, coverage's (including zone and man techniques), defending releases, downfield blocking, interception reads and techniques.
