The 2015 Magazine Drive has begun. The Drive will last approximately three weeks. Your son will receive materials during Orientation. If your son forgot his magazine packet at school you can go to Central Catholic's website for information and a link to the magazine webpage. **The first turn in day is Friday, September 4**. Subsequent return days as listed on the flyer are September 10, 15, 18, 22, and 25. The absolute last turn in day for the Drive will be Tuesday, September 29. **Online Orders placed by Midnight the night before the turn in day will count toward the homeroom totals for that turn in day**.

Each student will need to strive to reach his personal goal of EIGHT sales in order to earn a free personal day.
